Vegan Valley: Plot D £20,000

Hill and riverside plot adjacent to hardstanding and parking area. Steep hillside land for the most part but enjoying flatter parts by the river. Scope to extend boundary to owning both sides of the stream and provide own private parking area and gardens. Includes approximately 0.5 acre of dense woodland and a ruin. 2.5 acres FREEHOLD includes membership to community farm and communal areas with plunge pools, camping and campfire area and silver birch woodland.





Plot D is boundaried by Nant Ceir, a pretty babbling brook that stays flowing year-round! Whilst the hill itself is quite steep, there are some lovely flat areas by the water that make great glamping or camping spots in the summer and the hillside itself can be terraced if veg patches are required. We think it is perfect for tree planting and would be happy to help obtain sponsorship for free trees to anyone that wanted to be part of our giant edible

forest and yet be stewards of their own freehold plot. There is enough dead ash to supply ready seasoned wood for several years and we have have cool ideas about easy dig hillside compost toilets and 'easy-move' cabins.

Those that join our central community farm can enjoy the permitted development that comes with being part of a large agroecological farm. Would suit vegans and ecologists alike.
